APPLICATION

An application for a review of the premises licence of Atrium Alfresco, 4 Tegid Street, Bala has been received from John Alwyn Thomas, Licensing Enforcement Officer, Gwynedd Council.

This application is made by the licensing authority acting as responsible authority under the Licensing Act 2003. (The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 added licensing authorities to the list of responsible authorities under the Licensing Act 2003 on 25 April 2012.)

The application to review the premises licence relates to the following licensing objectives:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance

The grounds for review are:

- Carrying on licensable activities at times not in accordance with their licence.
- Failing to comply with conditions set by the Central Licensing Sub-Committee.

The premises licence for the Atrium Alfresco was initially granted following a hearing of the Central Licensing sub-committee on 10 November 2011. During this committee hearing the times for the licensable activities and opening hours of the premises were determined and the committee placed a condition for a CCTV system to be installed inside and outside the premises to the licence.

Witness statements provided by the applicant state that as a result of responding to complaints regarding noise and anti social behaviour on Tegid Street, Atrium Alfresco were found to be carrying on licensable activities outside their permitted hours on 09/06/2012 and 28/07/2012 respectively. Also, on 07/09/2012 as a result of an inspection of the premises with the licence holder, the premises was found to be without a CCTV system and Part B of their premises licence was not on display in accordance with requirements of the Licensing Act 2003.

The applicant recommends that the premises licence be amended as follows:

APPLICATION

An application for a review of the premises licence of Y Cwrt, 62 High Street, Bala has been received from John Alwyn Thomas, Licensing Enforcement Officer, Gwynedd Council.

This application is made by the licensing authority acting as responsible authority under the Licensing Act 2003. (The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 added licensing authorities to the list of responsible authorities under the Licensing Act 2003 on 25 April 2012.)

The application to review the premises licence relates to the following licensing objectives:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance

The grounds for review are:

- Carrying on the licensable activity of Late Night Refreshment not in accordance with their licence.

Witness statements provided by the applicant state that as a result of responding to complaints regarding noise and anti social behaviour on Tegid Street on 28/07/2012, Y Cwrt were found to be carrying on the licensable activity of providing Late Night Refreshment. The premises licence of Y Cwrt does not include the provision of Late Night Refreshments.

To control the instances of noise and anti-social behaviour in Bala, and to ensure that the licence holder complies with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003, the applicant recommends that the licence be amended as follows:

Also, an application to vary a premises licence be submitted by the licence holder so that the provision of Late Night Refreshments be added to the licence.

At the time of preparing this report one representation had been received from Williams Homes (Bala) Ltd expressing concern about the noise level and anti social behaviour taking place outside Y Cwrt.

RECOMMENDATION

The sub-committee is requested to consider the application to review the premises licence in accordance with the objectives of the Licensing Act 2003.
