Standards in Religious Education – progress in learning

- The pupils make good progress in their work that is reflected in the end of year assessments.
- There is a high percentage of pupils from EAL backgrounds. (20%). Despite that, several of them achieve high levels at the end of K.S.2
- The co-ordinator reported that the standard of the work in most of the books was good. There are several good examples of extended writing.
- Since 2010, an increase has occurred in the percentage of pupils achieving the higher levels in Religious Education.

Areas for Development

There is a need to ensure that the children have adequate opportunities to utilize thinking skills in the lessons so as to develop their learning independently.

Teaching: planning and range of strategies

- Religious education is taught for 10% of the time during the week in every class.
- The schemes are detailed and are based on the "Here I am" scheme.
- Quality of discussions held at the end of K.S.2 are mature.

- The lessons observed by the co-ordinator were of a high standard and showed progression throughout the school.
- ALN pupils are set differentiated work. Gifted pupils have an opportunity to practice extended writing and reflect on some of the world's fundamental questions.

- All the children are aware of the importance of courtesy during all services and contribute towards the spiritual ethos through silent meditation.

Areas for development as regards quality of Collective Worship

The senior pupils need to take more responsibility for preparing the whole school group services.
