APPLICATION

An application for a premises licence for The Victorian-N-Slipway, Marine Parade, Tywyn made by Mr Mark Andrew Greaves on behalf of the Victoria-N-Slipway Pub limited company, was received by the licensing authority on 17 August 2015. A copy of the application and premises plan is available in Appendix 1.

The applicant explains that this is an application for a new premises with a restaurant for a total of 150 covers located across two floors and that the premises has an outside balcony and a beer garden located to the side of the property.

A summary of the proposed licensable activities and opening hours of the premises is available in Appendix 2.

The steps the applicant intends to take to promote the four licensing objectives are listed in section M of the application.

Following discussions between North Wales Police and the applicant, the applicant has agreed to the CCTV conditions being included in the premises licence.

The representations received from the 7 other interested parties were objections to the application. Their objections are based upon the licensing objectives of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Prevention of Public Nuisance. The objectors main concerns include

- the late hours of operation being applied for
- the proximity of the premises to residential properties and therefore the likelihood of public nuisance being created, e.g. noise, anti-social behaviour and littering.
- the lack of parking facilities

RECOMMENDATION

The sub-committee is requested to consider the application for a premises licence in accordance with the objectives of the Licensing Act 2003 and Gwynedd Council's Statement of Licensing Policy.
