#### 1. APPLICATION RECEIVED

- 1.1 An application is attached for a premises licence for Beechwood House, Bridge Street, Dolgellau LL40 1AU from the applicant Dean Hawkins. The applicant is seeking a premises licence for a licensed shop and bar, by transforming the lower floor.
- 1.2 The application is made in relation to the sale of alcohol on and off the premises.
- 1.3 Officers from the Licensing Authority are satisfied that there is sufficient evidence that the application has been submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and the relevant regulations and is therefore valid.
- 1.4 One objection to the application has been received, and the applicant has agreed to public protection conditions in terms of a compromise to the opening hours. Police and the Fire and Rescue Service had no objection. The Police submitted comments in relation to CCTV.

### 2. Measures recommended by the applicant to promote the licensing objectives

Measures recommended by the applicant include the following -

- It is proposed to maintain the challenge 25 policy regarding the sale of alcohol, and children will not be allowed access to the premises after 8pm.
- A CCTV system is operational on the premises and at least one member of staff has been trained on how to use it. Images to be available to download for a period of at least 28 days at the request of the Police or the Council.
- Fire alarms will be installed and fire extinguishers situated in appropriate places.
- It is proposed to maintain noise levels to the minimum and not to place glass in the external bins after 9pm.

#### 3.2 <u>Nearby business</u>

One e-mail was received objecting to the application based on the licensing objectives of:

- Public nuisance prevention
- Prevention of crime and disorder

Concerns were expressed regarding anti-social matters in terms of noise, customers smoking outside and other sanitary issues behind the premises. See the attached e-mail to the application for full details.

## **Public Protection**

Observations and conditions were received from the Public Protection Department and the applicant agreed to compromise by amending the opening hours.

# 4 <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

It is recommended that this Committee approve the application - in accordance with what was agreed with Public Protection and the Police and in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003.
