1. APPLICATION RECEIVED

- 1.1 An application is attached for a premises licence for The Venu, Station Square, Pwllheli, Gwynedd, LL53 5HG from the applicant James Edward Rowley. The applicant is seeking a licence for premises that used to be licensed as a nightclub and restaurant until recently.
- 1.2 The application is made in relation to the sale of alcohol, live and recorded music, showing of live sports, the sale of alcohol and late night refreshments and live music on the premises, and recorded music on and off the premises.
- 1.3 Officers from the Licensing Authority are satisfied that there is sufficient evidence that the application has been submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003, and the relevant regulations and is therefore valid.
- 1.4 Representations were received on the application and the applicant agreed to include additional conditions in relation to CCTV at the request of the Police. Otherwise, no observations or objections to the application were received; and the application reflects what had been approved on the previous premises licence.

2. Measures recommended by the applicant to promote the licensing objectives

The measures recommended by the applicant include the following -

- A CCTV System is operated, and recordings of offences shall be available for 30 days
- Staff will help customers to make wise decisions in relation to the strength and measure of alcoholic drinks in order to encourage responsible drinking
- A zero tolerance drugs policy will be implemented
- Door supervisors licensed by the Security Industry Authority (SIA) will be used as necessary
- The licensee, or his representative, will be an operational member of the local Pubwatch Scheme
- Staff will be trained in health and safety matters that are relevant to their duties
- Staff will be trained what to do if there is a fire emergency
- Regular fire risk assessments will be undertaken
- Customers will be encouraged not to impair the local community in relation to the prevention of public nuisance
- Customers will be encouraged to leave quietly
- Customers will not be permitted to take glasses outside the premises
- A smoking area will be provided outside in a location that will not impair local residents
- A Challenge 25 alcohol sales policy will be implemented and responsible drinking is encouraged, and ID will be requested
- Staff will receive relevant training and records and details of the training will be kept.
