- Low level wards for employment deprivation such as Pentir 1 and Menai i.e. high level of population in work
- Density of the number of childcare locations relatively high in Bangor city
- Big employers located in this area such as Ysbyty Gwynedd, Bangor University etc.
- A number of Anglesey families using child care in Bangor city (childcare feasibility assessment statistics)
