BUT IF WE DO THIS, YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE SAID ...

The club is too far - it costs too much to travel!

I worry that less grants will mean less activities!

I'm too old to go to a club!

I prefer taking part in activities!

I want to talk to a Youth Worker whenever I need - not just in a youth club!



BUT IF WE DO THIS, THE EQUALITIES IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND OPTIONS ASSESSMENT HAVE IDENTIFIED ...

A larger number of young people will not be able to access the service - we would only be present in **SOME** communities!, and travelling to us would be difficult

We won't be meeting Welsh Governments expectations - Youth Work Strategy, or the Youth Engagement Framework

Recruiting and training staff will continue to be a challenge!
