1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 During the process of creating the Council's Committees Calendar for 2018/19, members were invited through *Rhaeadr* to express their opinion on the timetable for the Council's Committee meetings for 2018/19.
- 1.2 The purpose was to ensure that the Council allows all members the opportunity to participate in the democratic process, therefore making every effort to hold meetings at suitable locations and at a reasonable time so as to assist members to fulfill their roles effectively.
- 1.3 Comments have been received from two Councillors in response to the request issued in *Rhaeadr*. The comments varied from adhering to the current arrangements, to the need to take into account various issues such as locating more meetings at Penrhyndeudraeth where possible, to ensuring that meetings do not commence before 10am. These issues will be addressed through the Democratic Services Committee.
- 1.4 Consultation on the draft calendar of the Council's Committees 2018/19 have taken place with the Snowdonia National Park to ensure that there are no clashes between the committee meetings of both organisations.

- 2.1 The Calendar listing the dates of meetings of the Council's main committees for 2018/19 is presented overleaf.
- 2.2 These are the dates we are scheduling for now, however, it may be necessary to hold additional meetings in order to ensure the smooth running of Council business.
