1. Background

The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee of the Ombudsman's decisions on formal complaints against members.

2. Decisions

Complaint 7294/201806883

Complaint by a member of a community council that a fellow member had:

- Compromised the impartiality of the Clerk of the council, and had conducted a bullying campaign against him with the assistance of the Clerk
- Failed to declare a prejudicial interest and predetermined the outcome of the Council's Personnel Committee meeting, where a complaint made against the Clerk by the complainant was considered

The Ombudsman decided not to investigate the complaint for the following reasons:

- No evidence submitted to support the complainant's version of events of a campaign of bullying
- No evidence submitted of a connection between the member and the clerk (other than the relationship that all members have)
