Dear Heilyn

I object to an application for a premises licence, ref. 098082, from Motor Fuel Ltd. (LL49 9NG) due to concerns relating to the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety and the Protection of Children from Harm.

Firstly, the application includes the words "Convenience Store" and "Filling Station" under the address details of the site. I have never been aware of the premises being referred to as a "Convenience Store" before.

Occasionally, serious problems are caused by vehicles queuing for fuel on and around the site. This creates congestion on the High Street and on Heol Madog as well as disorder and a risk of accidents. It is very reasonable to estimate that extending the range of services on the site would have a detrimental impact on the situation.

The applicants request the right to sell alcohol between 0600 and 2300 every day. But other premises on the High Street in Porthmadog currently have the right to operate between 0800 until 11:00 and between 0800 until 1030 on Sundays.

Also, Porthmadog Town Council and the Eifionydd Policing Group have recently supported my efforts to ensure a 'bottle labels' condition on other licences.
