1. The Scrutiny Investigation was established on 2 February 2023 and the draft Final Report is submitted for the attention of Members.
2. Members of the Scrutiny Committee are asked to consider the contents of the Report and to make comments, ask any relevant questions, propose any amendments, and approve the Report.
3. The Cabinet Member is asked for her response to the main findings and recommendations and to confirm if she accepts the recommendations.
4. If the investigation's report is approved, a decision will need to be reached on when to receive an update from the Cabinet Member for Education on implementation per recommendation.
5. During the period of the investigation, the Full Council at its meeting on 4 May 2023, adopted a Notice of Motion submitted by Councillor Rhys Tudur, namely:

“In order for the Council to be innovative in its method of monitoring the implementation of Welsh medium education and progress in detail and effectively in our schools, I ask the Education and Economy Scrutiny Committee to consider the most appropriate way of gathering data and monitoring the Welsh-medium provision in every secondary school against the baselines of the categories in which the schools are included.”

Taking into consideration the work of the investigation and specifically Recommendations 1 and 2, the Committee needs to conclude if there is further work to be done or if what has been achieved by the investigation meets the requirement.
